### 5 Common Causes of Slide-Out Failure

- 1 Lack of Lubrication
- 2 Moisture and Corrosion
- 3 Low Battery Voltage
- 4 Debris in Tracks
- 5 Sticking Seals and Gaskets

### Warning Signs to Watch For

- Grinding or unusual noises
- Slow or jerky movement
- Slide-out stops partway
- Uneven extension or retraction
- Visible rust or worn seals

Don't Force It: If your slide-out hesitates, binds, or makes unusual noises, stop and inspect it. Forcing the system can turn a minor repair into a major one.
